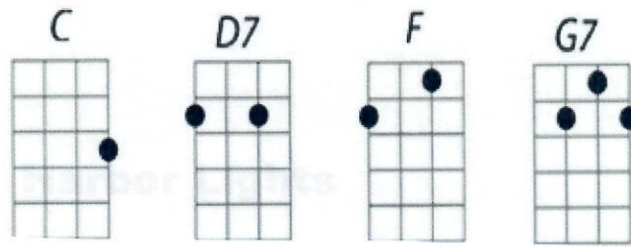


Harbor Lights
