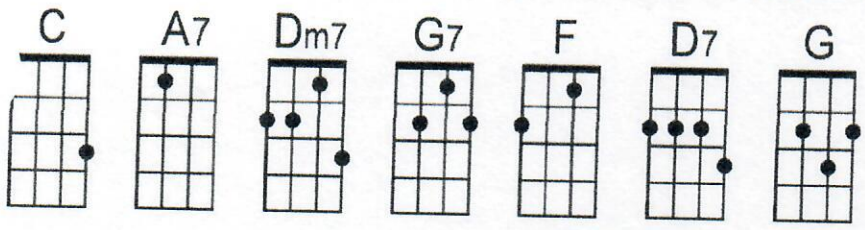


What a Day For a Daydream (Key of C)
