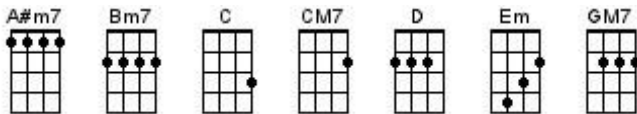


Don't Let the Sun Catch You Crying
