Gene Autry sang this title song in the movie with the Cass County Boys, the first film he made after leaving military service at the end of World War II. The most successful recording was by Bing Crosby who recorded the song on December 27, 1945. It reached the No. 3 position on Billboard's Best-selling Record charts during a 16-week stay.
