

KEY TRANSPOSING CHART



- Is a song too high or low for your voice?
- Are the chords difficult to play on a Uke?
- Or, do you want to play along with a recording but the key is different?

You can transpose any song to a new key by using this chart

Find the **Old Key** in the left column and the **New Key** in the right column. Now change (transpose) all the chords in the song from those in the **Old Key** row to those in the **New Key** row. For example, to change a song from the key of **E** (a good guitar player's key, but a tough ukulele playing key) to the key of **C** (a great ukulele playing key), find "**E**" under **Old Key** and then "**C**" under **New Key**. Now you can see, that all the chords in that song that started with "**E**" would now start with "**C**." So, in this example a **B7** would become a **G7**, and a **Bm6** would now be a **Gm6**, and so on.

• You can also use this chart to place a capo for a quick key change.
