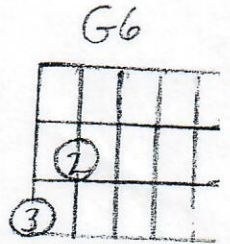

C'est si bon, lovers say that in France,



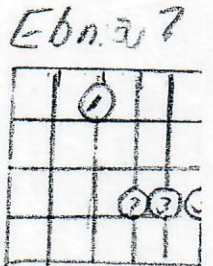

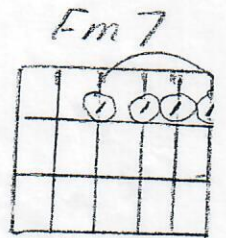
