<sup>A</sup> All my worry blew / <sup>F#m7</sup> away / when you taught me how to / <sup>B7</sup> say <sup>E7</sup>

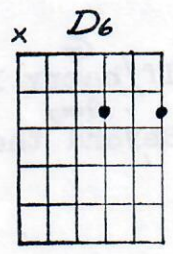


<sup>E7</sup> Grab your / <sup>A</sup> coat and get your / <sup>C#7</sup> hat
